# M02SPS Theories of Career Choice and Development

The aim of this module is to develop students' in-depth knowledge and critical understanding of the theories that seek to account for career choice, learning and development, as well as those relating to change management and motivation.



Students will be encouraged to explore the psychological and sociological basis of the theories, and their links to models of learning. In addition, the module will critically examine the ways in which career patterns develop in contemporary political, economic, social and technological contexts; and the relevance of change management and motivation theories to career choice and development.
